

The tree was also near a wood fired bread oven, before dawn he would come down from the tree when the fire was stoked for the morning baking, for further warmth. The technical design of the dimensional weave has won Maximo many fiber arts awards and his pieces are part of the Smithsonian Native American Museum collection.
